Unlike other funeral homes, we do not take a commission on pre-paid funerals and our pre-paid Trust does not apply annual fees.



WHAT TO DO WHEN SOMEONE DIES

Call us at Beauchamp Funeral Home so we can support and guide you through the process.

DEATH AT HOME

If a relative or friend dies at home, the first person you should contact is their Doctor. They may be able to issue a *Medical Cause of Death* certificate. Next, call us, Beauchamp Funeral Home so we are able to make arrangements to transfer them into our care at the appropriate time.

DEATH IN A HOSPITAL OR NURSING HOME

In this instance, the staff or Charge Nurse will be able to help you with arrangements to have a Doctor issue a *Medical Cause of Death* certificate. As soon as possible you should call us and we will begin liaising with the hospital or Nursing Home to make arrangements from there.

SUDDEN OR UNEXPECTED DEATH

If the death is sudden or unexpected, the Doctor may contact the Police. They may arrange for that person to be taken from the place of death to the hospital for the Coroner to investigate and determine the cause of death which may involve a post mortem examination. In the meantime you can contact us and we will make arrangements with the Coroner's office on your behalf, to make arrangements from there.

DEATH OVERSEAS

If the death occurs away from home (overseas), we are able to attend to the extensive process of contacting government departments and the funeral home in that country, on your behalf. We will take care of all necessary documentation and arranging for the person to be brought home.

THE ROLE OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR
